AIR PERMITTING: Air permitting for data centers is primarily driven by the need to regulate emissions from generators and on-site generation, cooling towers, and other equipment that may emit pollutants. Geosyntec develops air permitting strategies to provide operational flexibility, minimize compliance burdens, and expedite the permitting process.



AIR MODELING: Before construction or operation, data centers often need to conduct air dispersion modeling to demonstrate compliance with ambient air quality standards. Geosyntec routinely conducts modeling to evaluate potential off-site impacts associated with risk assessments and hazard analyses.



NOISE MITIGATION & INDOOR AIR: Noise pollution and indoor air quality can cause serious consequences for data center employees. Geosyntec's team of air quality experts assess and mitigate indoor air quality issues such as dust and humidity and conduct noise assessments using predictive modeling and on-site measurements to achieve and maintain compliance with local regulations.



AIR QUALITY COMPLIANCE OBLIGATIONS: Once permitted, data centers must maintain compliance through routine reporting and recordkeeping reporting, adhering to site-specific permit conditions. 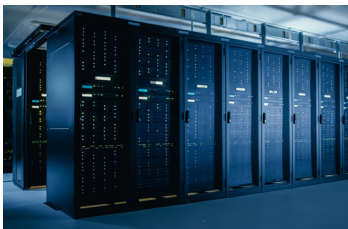
Air Permitting and Modeling for Data Centers | California, US
